1. Why can't we see Jesus? - How would you answer this question if a five year old approached you and asked it?
2. Linden's sermon question - God's word states, "Ask it and shall be given to you". (Matt 7:7)
Also, Mark 20 states that if you ask and believe in your heart that you will receive, then it will be so.
How would you answer the question of, "Why isn't God answering my prayers?"
3. Does God's will change? Does praying and asking God for something mean that his Will will change because of what you prayed for.

Think of Old Testament prophets who interceded on behalf of their people.
